Grant of Exclusive Right of Burial (Clause 25)

By virtue of the Cemeteries Act 1986, The Shire of Williams in consideration of the sum shown hereunder paid by the payer indicated on behalf of the Grantee names in the Schedule, hereby grants to the Grantee the right of burying bodies in that piece of ground within the Row and Number on the plan of the cemetery as shown hereunder.

This grant is valid for the period of twenty five years, from the date hereof, for the purpose of interment only.

This grant is issued subject to all local laws and regulations, now or hereafter in force, made, or to be made under the above Act, or any future Act or Acts.
